

## Life Tool Kit Project

Every woman who walks into Project Hope is a woman of strength. At Project Hope each woman is given the tools she needs to succeed through our workforce development, housing support, education, and business enterprise programs. The Life Tool Kit provides each woman in our shelter with another set of tools.

We would like to provide each woman moving into shelter a kit with all the “tools” she needs to succeed while at Project Hope. When a family moves into their own housing, we want to provide them with another “tool” kit to prepare them for the responsibilities of being in their own home. The goal of these kits is to provide those little things that will help ease these major transitions.

### What can you do?

We welcome Volunteer Groups to assemble the Life Tool Kits for the women at Project Hope. This is an excellent project for any size group. Your group will organize and finance the purchase of the items as well as assemble the Life Tool Kits. We suggest you assemble at least 11 kits which is the number of families at our shelter. We also encourage you to add a personal touch to the kits by adding an inspirational card or message. Below are some of the items we suggest for the Life Tool Kits:

Moving into Shelter – We ask that items are stored in a plastic storage bin that can be reused

- Daily Planner
- Journal
- Pens/Pencils
- Large Binder
- New set of Towels
- New set of Twin Sheets
- Basket of Toiletries
- Wrapping paper for a child’s birthday present
- Children’s Book – (under age 12)

Moving into an Apartment – We ask that items are stored in a plastic storage bin that can be reused

- Daily planner
- Journal
- Pens/Pencils
- Memo Pads
- Portable filing system for bills
- Calculator
- Phone card
- Stamps and envelopes
- Clock
- Gift Card for Groceries
- Basic Tools: Hammer, screwdriver, small nails, tape measure
